ADM Sevilla 2026 reaches 186 registered companies from 16 countries two months ahead of the event

Andalucía TRADE and BCI Aerospace are organising the 8th edition of the event, from 19 to 21 May, further consolidating its international profile, with 58% of participating contractors (OEMs) coming from abroad.

With just under two months to go before Aerospace & Defense Meetings – ADM Sevilla 2026, the event has already attracted 186 registered companies from 16 countries, representing a 22.4% increase compared with the same period ahead of the previous edition. The event, which will take place from 19 to 21 May at FIBES, is once again demonstrating strong international appeal and sustained growth across the global aerospace and defence industry.

Organised by the Regional Government of Andalusia, through the Department of Economy, Finance, European Funds and Social Dialogue and its agency Andalucía TRADE, in collaboration with BCI Aerospace, the eighth edition of ADM Sevilla is further consolidating its international positioning. Notably, 58% of registered contractors (OEMs) are international, underlining the global reach and attractiveness of the event.

After seven successful editions, ADM Sevilla has firmly established itself as Spain's leading aerospace business convention and the most important event of its kind in Southern Europe. Its continued expansion reinforces Andalusia's role as a strategic hub within the global aerospace value chain and strengthens the international visibility of the region's industrial ecosystem.

The current registration figures confirm both the scale and quality of participation. To date, 162 companies have registered as exhibitors, representing a 32% increase compared to the same stage ahead of ADM Sevilla 2024, including 68 international exhibitors. In addition, 24 original equipment manufacturers (OEMs) have confirmed their participation, 14 of which are based outside Spain. This strong international representation reflects the growing global relevance of the event.

ADM Sevilla 2026 once again brings together leading players from the European, Spanish and Andalusian aerospace industries. Airbus, Europe's largest aerospace manufacturer, will participate as the event's main partner. The event is further supported by major companies

such as Aciturri as Platinum Sponsor, and Pilatus Aircraft, Akkodis, Sofitec, Turboco Española, Aerotecnic and GSC (Grupo Sevilla Control) as Gold Sponsors, contributing to a high-level ecosystem of industrial excellence and innovation.

The event also benefits from the institutional support of key stakeholders in Spain's aerospace and defence sectors, including TEDAE, Andalucía Aerospace, the Spanish Space Agency (AEE) and CATEC (Advanced Center for Aerospace Technologies of Andalusia).

The leading event in Spain

ADM Sevilla has become a key platform for business development and international collaboration in the aerospace and defence sectors. Its objective is to strengthen the competitiveness and turnover of the Andalusian and Spanish aerospace industry, while promoting international growth opportunities across civil aviation, defence and space activities.

Carolina España, Regional Minister of Economy, highlighted the “remarkably high participation levels already achieved by ADM Sevilla, even with more than two months remaining before the event, as well as the strong presence of major international contractors and leading global manufacturers.” She emphasised that this reflects the event's growing prestige and its ability to position the Andalusian aerospace cluster at the forefront of the international industry.

“Through ADM Sevilla, the Regional Government of Andalusia aims to provide global supply chain stakeholders with a unique platform to connect, exchange ideas and explore new business opportunities,” she added, noting that the event further strengthens Andalusia's role as a key aerospace hub in Spain and a strategic destination for foreign investment.

According to the latest available data, the Andalusian aerospace sector comprises 147 companies, employing more than 15,000 people. The sector generated a turnover of €2.914 billion in 2024, up 6.8% compared to the previous year, and exports reached €2.811 billion, representing a 34% increase.

To date, participating companies in ADM Sevilla 2026 come from 16 countries across four continents, with a strong international presence from Europe and beyond, including Italy, France, Germany, the United Kingdom and the United States, as well as participants from Canada, India, Turkey and other markets. Spanish companies also represent a significant share of participation, particularly from Andalusia, Catalonia, the Basque Country and Madrid.

As in previous editions, ADM Sevilla 2026 will be co-funded by the European Union under the FEDER Operational Programme for Andalusia 2021–2027, with up to 85% EU contribution, or through other eligible European funding instruments.

Andalucía TRADE and the sector

Since its launch, ADM Sevilla has played a key role in promoting the internationalisation of the Andalusian aerospace sector. This initiative is part of a broader strategy led by Andalucía TRADE, in coordination with the Andalucía Aerospace cluster, which includes a year-round

programme of activities such as Aeroday, as well as targeted investment attraction through the Invest in Andalucía initiative.

A recent example of this strategy is the establishment of Pilatus Aircraft in Seville, making Andalusia the only region in Spain to host production facilities from two major OEMs: Airbus and Pilatus Ibérica.
